Jean-Philippe, 'JP', is known for bringing lasting solutions to unsolved equine problems. Jean Philippe, an experienced dressage rider, has evented, show-jumped, trained horses to Grand Prix, and coached Olympic level riders from six countries. Among many other classicists, 'JP' studied with Master Nuno Oliveira and the German master Herbert Rehbein. 'JP' is renowned for teaching piaffe and passage, and an ardent proponent of working equitation.

Working equitation is a new international sport open to all levels of riders and all breeds using the tack and costume of each country from the dressage, hunter/jumper, and Western traditions. Working equitation competitions have four phases: dressage; ease of handling using obstacles such as a gate, a bell, a bridge, a key hole, balls, barrels, jumps, lances, and poles; a timed obstacle speed phase; and, sometimes a team penning phase.
