For board payment checks we have our new box located on the wall just inside the Welcome Center front entrance. As always, please include your horse's name in the memo section of all checks.

For all trailer-in clients/students we ask that a Liability Waiver be signed before they ride or unload horse(s). Waivers are located in a white binder on the granite counter in the Welcome Center.

It is imperative that ALL boarders' occupy lockers numbered to correlate with their horses' stall number(s). With a lot of stall moves lately, lockers have been mixed-up. (i.e. If your horse is in stall #3 your locker is #3.) Also, please be sure to occupy only one locker per horse owned. This is very important as we have so many new boarders coming-in and upon their arrival are in need of their stall-number assigned lockers.

Sign-up sheets will be posted (before the end of this month) in each barn for Spring shots and Coggins.

We now have an e-mail information center to send messages from the Farm to Boarders and Trainers. Our purpose for this is to inform all subscribers of important messages (i.e. snow-removal, arena closures, etc.); and to avoid someone driving a long-distance to the Farm and not be able to use the arena(s).
